

Documents Needed:

You will need records of income earned in the year prior to when you will start school. You may also need records of your parents' income information if you are a dependent student.

-Your Social Security Number (Be sure it is correct!)

-Your Driver's License (If any)

-Your PIN if submitting FAFSA electronically

-Your 2009 W-2 Forms and other records of money earned

-Your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2009 Federal Income Tax Return.

- IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ
- Foreign Tax Return, or
- Tax Return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federal States of Micronesia, or Palau

-Your Parents' 2009 Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student)

-Your 2009 untaxed income records

- Veterans benefits records
- Child support received
- Worker's compensation

-Your current bank statements

-Your current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond and other investment records

-Your alien registration or permanent resident card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)

To organize your information, print and complete a FAFSA on the Web Worksheet before you begin entering your information online.
